Meetings next year: It was tabled at the Committee meeting that it may be more suitable for parents to have the meetings on LDC days, 9:00am to 11:00am so that children can be cared for at the Centre and we are not taking parents out at night. We have traditionally met at night as we had a bigger number of working families. When I first started here in 2001 it was held in the morning in the cot room at the Centre. We now have a group of parents who are not in the traditional way "working" committee members. This suggestion is open for discussion and will be tabled at the first meeting next year on Monday 12th February at 6:30pm. Come with your thoughts on this or let Committee members know your ideas.

Enrolment packages: It would be appreciated if these could be returned soon so that we can make plans for 2018 and have a general idea of families intended usage of LDC and PS places. If you know of anyone requiring an enrolment package please notify the Centre.

Fees for 2018 will remain the same and be reviewed when our funding for LDC sustainability is received in July 2018. Preschool is \$15 per day, \$5 for low income or indigenous children and LDC is \$50 per permanent day or \$56 for casual places. Remember CCB is also changing in July 2018 and this may make a difference for families.

CONCERT: We have purchased clothing for your child for the concert. These are a gift to your children. The boys have a Christmas themed t-shirt which will go home before the event (hopefully they are the correct size for your child). If you could dress the boys in jeans long or short on the night with the t-shirt that would be great. The girls have some special dresses/tops to wear .. some may be shortish and need leggings underneath or nice shorts to complement the outfit. These will also be sent home before the event for you to make certain they are all OK. Our concert looks as if it will be a very colourful event.

We are doing a sausage sizzle on the night for all families and ask if you could provide some fruit and nibbles for after the concert for sharing that would be terrific. We request that families do a calculation of how many sausage sandwiches (one sausage on a slice of bread with onion if required) you would eat along with your extended family so that we can order in the amount needed.
